

Aviação no CELE / EU ETS Aviation

Scope

The aircraft activities are in the scope of European Union Emissions Trading Scheme (EU ETS) since it was published the Directive 2008/101/EC, 19 November 2008, amending Directive 2003/87/EC. This Directive adds to the Annex I – the activities in the scope of EU ETS – the aviation activities. This Directive was transposed into the Portuguese Law by the Decree-Law n. 9 93/2010, 27th of July.

To clarify the aviation activities included in the scope of the EU ETS the European Commission (EC) published the <u>Decision n. º 2009/450/EC, 8 June 2009</u>, on the detailed interpretation of the aviation activities listed in Annex I to Directive 2003/87/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council.

In the scope of the *Compliance Forum* it was prepared a document: "Questions and answers report", in order to help the implementation of the Directive 2008/101/CE.

Accordingly with the stipulated in the Directive 2008/101/CE the EC must publish annually an aircraft operators list, the last publication was the Regulation (EU) n.º 100/2012, 3 February 2012 amending Regulation n.º 748/2009.

The methodology applied to generate the above mentioned list it is described in the document: "<u>EU Emissions Trading Scheme Aircraft operator allocation by EC Member State</u> Process description".
